## Class 1

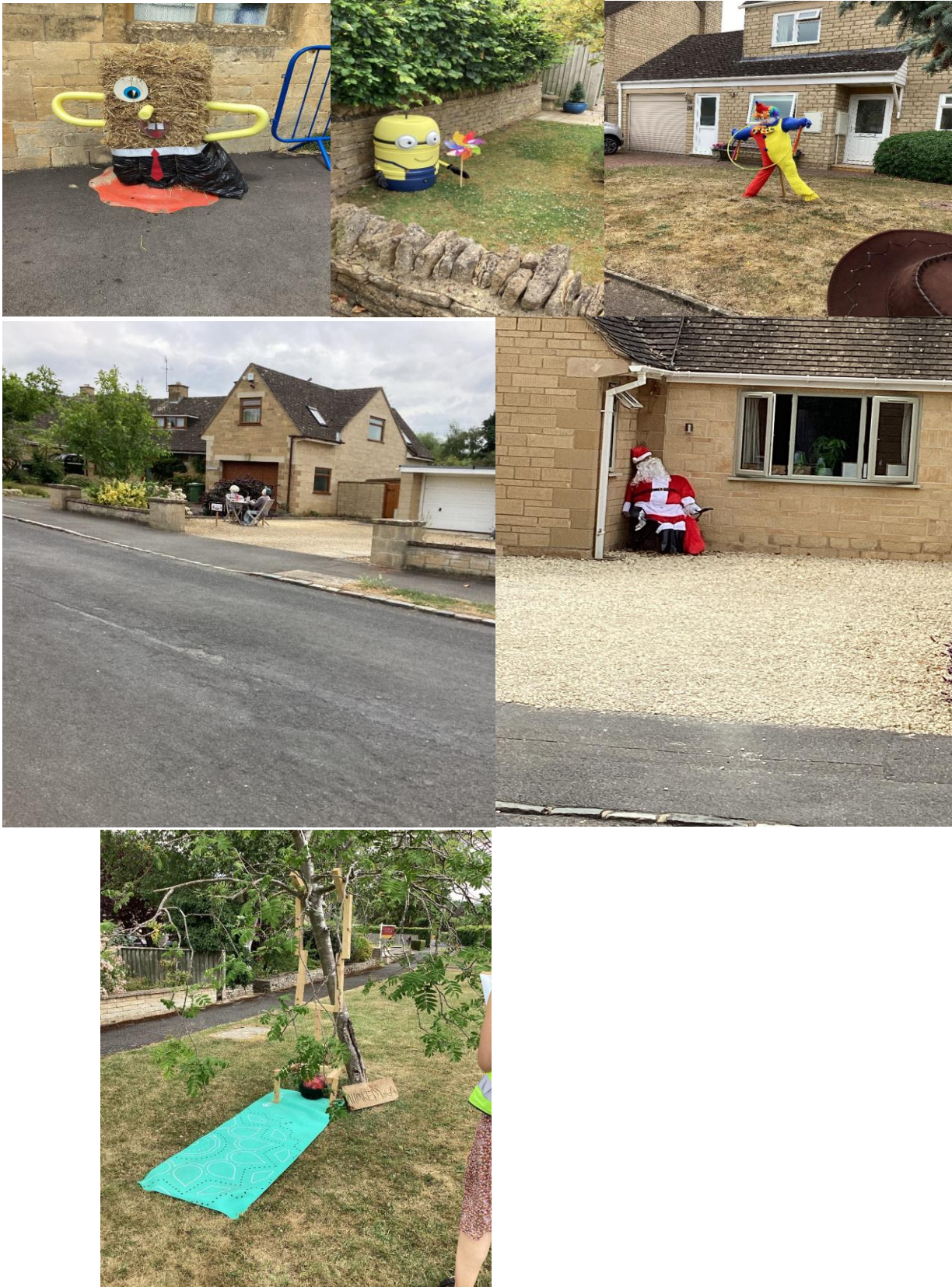

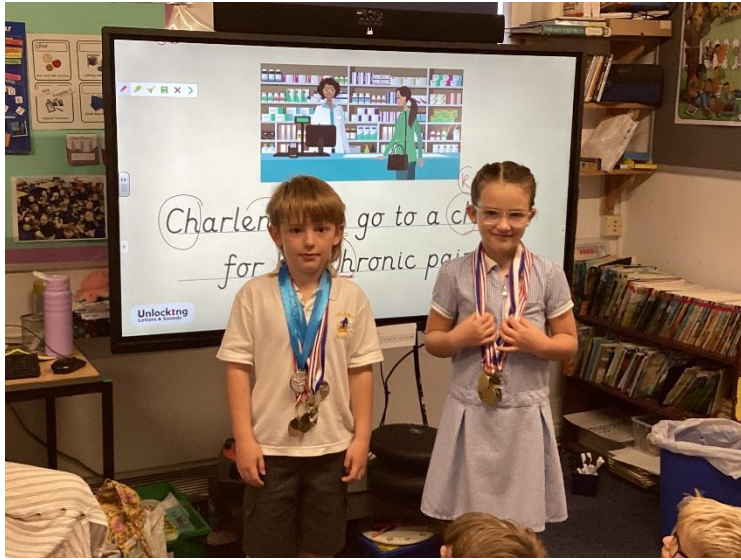
## Geography

As we come to end of our story, My Dad's a birdman, we have been focusing on poetry writing to bring a scene alive and convey the characters emotions.

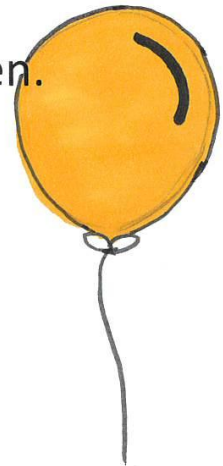
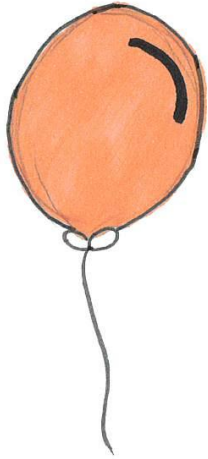
