Class 1

English

The children are absolutely loving our Paddington Bear theme! They've been really enjoying using their special diaries—which they decorated themselves—to write about their own adventures, as well as pretending to be Paddington and recounting his exciting escapades. We've been focusing on writing in the past tense, using time connectives, and remembering to capitalise proper nouns.

Maths

In maths, we've been learning about fractions. The children took part in practical activities to help them recognise halves and understand that a half means splitting something into two *equal* parts.

Science

In science, we've continued our topic on *Plants*, looking closely at plant life cycles through the lovely story *The Tiny Seed* by Eric Carle. Inspired by the book, the children created beautiful collages in the style of Eric Carle, which they thoroughly enjoyed—and they look fantastic on our classroom display!

Maths

Time has been our topic in Maths, learning to tell the time each hour down to telling the time to the closest five minutes. The children have worked really hard using clocks to support their work. Plenty of practice at home as well as at school will help to continue this learning.

English

In English we have been using the Story 'My Dad is a Birdman' to write diaries and newspaper articles. We have also explored characters and how they interact with each other through dialogue.

Science

Plants has been the focus in Science. We have been looking at the different functions of parts of a plant and the process of growth and pollination.

We have been heading to the village field for PE to practicing our long distance running as well as our athletic jumping and throwing. We will be continuing with this theme for the rest of the term.

Big congratulations to Jack who took part in the Willersey King Charles Cup run up to Saintbury Church and back. He was the first back for the school, to win the school cup, but also was first back overall beating all the adults too in a time of 12 mins 30 seconds and therefore won both cups!!! Hopefully Jack will be bringing the cups into school to show everybody!
