## Class 1

In English, we've been learning how to write persuasive texts—and the children have certainly put their powers of persuasion to good use! As a class, we've been trying to convince Mr Jackson to let us keep a pet dinosaur. The children then innovated their writing with their own ideas, including persuasive letters asking for pet rabbits, puppies, horses, a 'bring your pet to school day', and even ice lollies at the end of term! They've worked hard to include boastful adjectives and persuasive language to make their arguments as convincing as possible.

## Maths

In Maths, we have been looking at statistics, learning how to collect and present data using tally charts, pictograms, and block diagrams. It's been great fun discovering each other's favourite colours, pizza toppings, and sports through different recording methods!

## Geography

In Geography, we continued with our topic 'Is it Hot or Cold?' The children can now name the seven continents and five oceans, and they've been learning to identify hot and cold areas of the world, along with the differences in climate. We looked more closely at the polar regions, and the children carried out research, designed posters, and proudly presented what they had learnt about the Arctic and Antarctica.

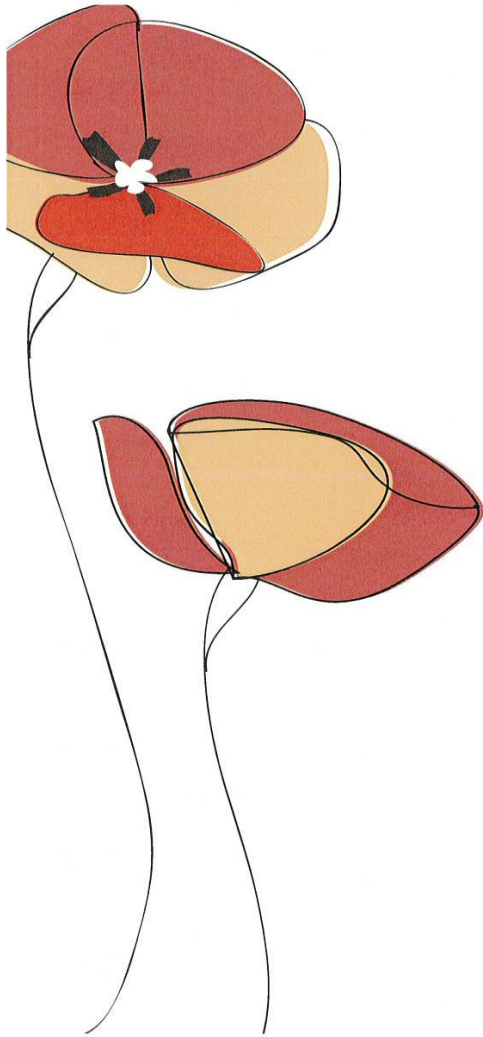
