Class 1

English

In English, we have started exploring recounts and diary entries—all with a Paddington Bear theme, which the children are absolutely loving! We're focusing on writing in the past tense, using the first person, and including time connectives such as *First*, *Next*, *After that*, and *Finally*.

Maths

In Maths, our focus has been on money. The children have enjoyed lots of hands-on activities, including role-playing bus journeys where they practised selecting the correct coins and calculating change for their tickets.

Science

In science, we've begun our new topic on *Plants*. So far, we've been learning about the different parts of plants and trees. Over the next couple of weeks, we'll be heading outdoors to identify plants in our local area!

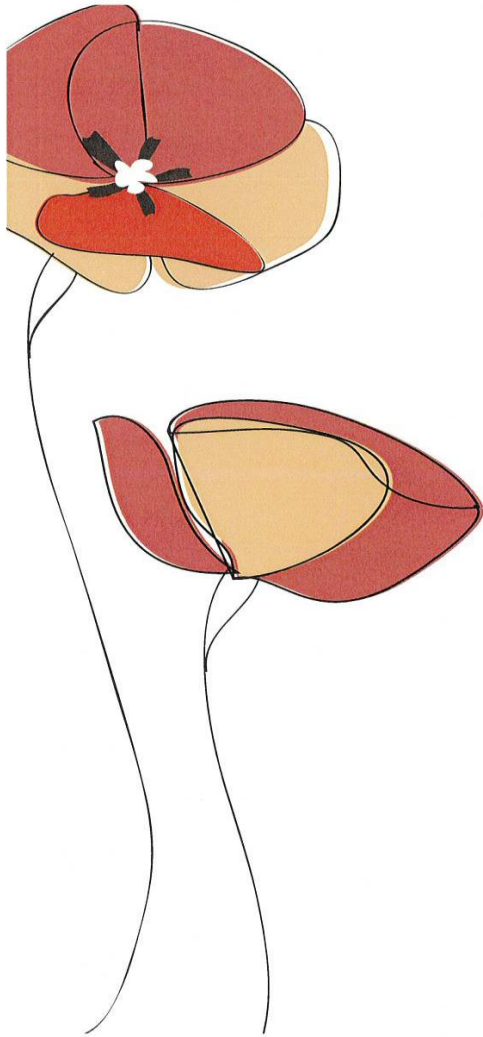
