Class 1

The children of Class 1 are learning all about the weather! They have a new weather station and are busy taking daily measurements of wind speed and direction, temperature and rainfall!



In Maths, we are looking at Place values (one more and one less); in English, we are studying 'The Papaya that spoke'!

Class 2

We have been exploring elephants in English. Thinking about the different topics we can write about such as diet, habitat and features, we have begun to write reports. This is the start of our work on 'The Girl who Stole an elephant' by Nizrana Farook.

In Maths, we are working on Place value. Using different counters to help us identify the value of integers within a small and large number we are getting more confident with our place value.

Bones and our skeleton is our first Science Topic of the year and using Barry the skeleton we have been discussing the different types of bones and joints within the body.

In Geography, we are studying International Trade, we have already been looking at the producers of different food and drink and where in the world this comes from.
