Class 1

We've had a very special visitor, Nibbles the Book Monster! He's been nibbling on all sorts of things in our classroom, but his mischief has given the children a brilliant drive for their writing. They have absolutely loved this unit and have produced some fantastic work. We are focusing on using coordination (and, but, or), adding adjectives and expanded noun phrases to make our writing more descriptive, and practising adding plurals (s, es) where needed.

In maths, we are now exploring place value within 100, developing our understanding of tens and ones. Reception have been focusing on shapes and triangles and are now looking at the composition of numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

In science, the children have been learning about different habitats and exploring the differences between living and non-living things.

In geography, we have started our new unit Let's Explore the World, where the children have been learning how to use an atlas and understanding compass directions. Next, we will be exploring map keys.

In RE, we've begun our new unit with the big question: Why does Christmas matter to Christians and how do people celebrate it? The children are enjoying learning about the meaning of Christmas and how it is celebrated around the world.

Class 2

On Wednesday 19th November we had our last school photos of 2025.

In geography we are learning about Europe, Asia, Africa, North and South America, Antarctica and Australia. In science we are learning about the properties of solid, liquid and gas.

In English we are reading a book called *Leon and the place between* by Angela McAllister and Grahame Baker-Smith, in R.E we are learning about different religions. In maths we are learning about composite and prime numbers only for year 5 and 6 but year 3 and 4 are doing multiplication.

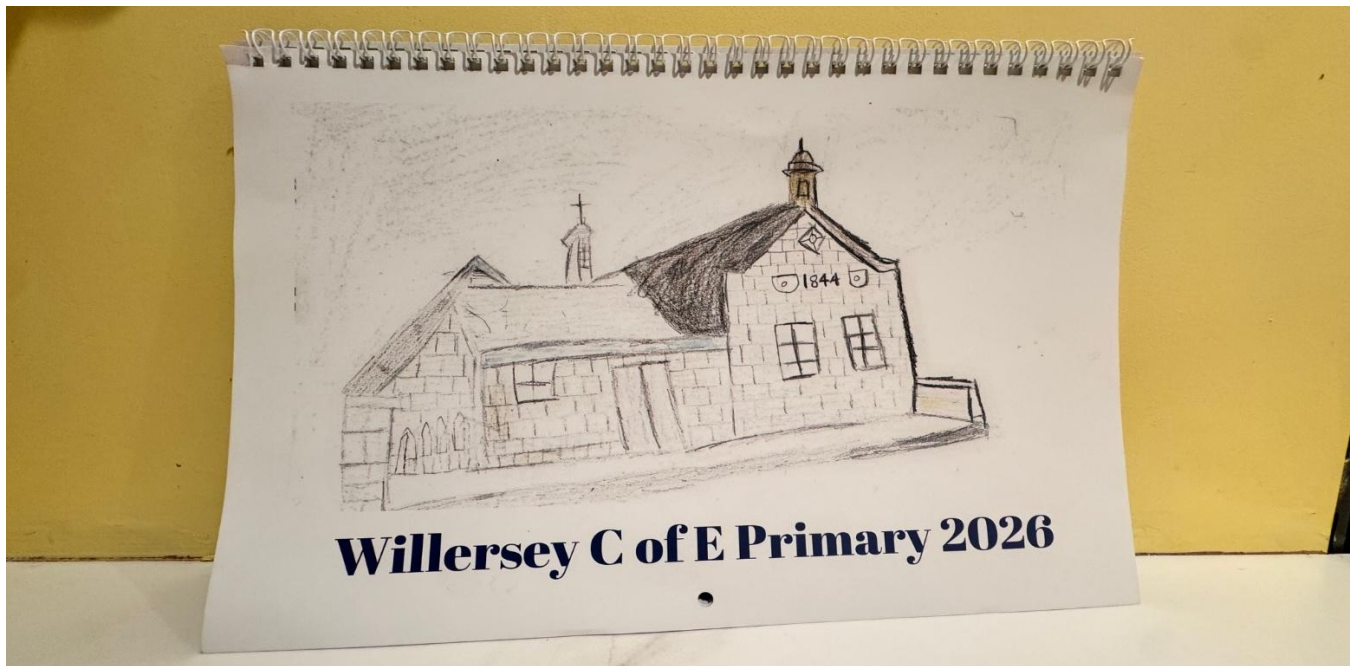
